










The Doha Beach Club occupies an expansive 18,000m² site, accessible via both water and the corniche. The ground floor hosts the entrance, main hall, all restaurant and sports facilities, a dining hall, a double-height lounge, and squash courts. On the upper floor, one finds the library, a television room, and a recreation space. Overnight accommodations reside in a semi-detached unit connected to the main building through a garden. Designed to shield against intense sunlight, the outdoor bar adjacent to the swimming pool features a roof extension, while a pergola partially shades the solarium.

A columnar structural system supports the post-stressed reinforced-concrete waffle roof, distinguishing the façade, interior walls, and upper floor slab within this unified structure. Concrete walls are finished with paint, ceilings are plastered, and floors are adorned with tiles or carpeting. Additionally, exterior protrusions of the roof slab are clad in wooden slats.
